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The Staff Accountability Process

The staff accountability process permits staff to report their evacuation status. This process saves lives and is the responsibility of every person. If first responders know that they do not have to travel to certain floors, it can save their lives and permits them to focus on the safety of others who may still be in the building and require their help. If the staff accountability process is not performed, information about missing and dead may be erroneous.
